Coaching Courses

The South West Federation arranges several coaching courses. These include Improver's Coaching, Towards the Triple Peel and Development Course in Advanced Play but as these mostly happen before SWAN is published, they will be advertised on the SWF website within the next week or so or you can find them at the end of the newsletter. If you want to improve your game or become a coach or a referee, one of these courses may interest you.

2013 CA Tournaments

The tournaments fixture book will be sent to CA members early in January but if you want to start planning your year before then you will find a draft calendar on the CA website.

From the home page, click on Tournaments, then Fixtures Calendar. You then need to tick the Draft Entries box (which you will find under "Display Options") and then click on Choose Year / 2013 in the top left of the screen.

HIGH BISQUERS TOURNAMENT

Each year, there are a few tournaments aimed at those who have a handicap of between 12 and 24. They are an excellent way of discovering the delights of tournament play and designed for those who are new to the game to gain experience. If you have not yet tried one out, they are to be thoroughly recommended. The first to be advertised for the coming season so far is at Cheltenham on Tuesday 18 - Thursday 20 June. Details will be published in SWAN (the South West Area Newsletter) which you will receive in late March.

Cheltenham also hosts CA TOURNAMENTS and if you are not a member of the Croquet Association you are permitted to enter one CA tournament before you have to join. There are handicap tournaments (for those with a handicap of 20 or less) at Cheltenham on the Easter weekend - 29th March - 1st April; 25th - 27th May; 5th - 7th July; and 17th - 19th September. There is also a handicap doubles tournament on 16th - 18th August. Details from Robert.

If you have already had your "one permitted" CA tournament, perhaps now is the time for you to join the CA. You will then receive the Fixtures Book in January which details the hundreds of tournaments around the country ensuring you never have a dull moment next year. Details of how to join the CA are available on their website or from Robert. Subs for the first two years are subsidised (just £13.50 for the first year) rising to the normal rate of £46 p.a. in the third year.
